



Religious Education Curriculum Focus Areas - YEAR 2

How do we share God's messages about Creation?

Students recognise the sacredness of God and all Creation. They suggest ways to pursue peace and justice out of respect for all Creation. Students recognise that prayer and the wisdom of saints help the believer to nurture their relationship with Creation. They participate in meditative prayer experiences.

Lent and Easter

Students analyse some teachings and actions of Jesus depicted in New Testament texts that reveal aspects of God's nature.

How do the stories of Jesus give meaning to our community today?

Students pose questions about the life and times of Jesus and use sources provided to answer these questions. They make connections between Jesus' teachings and actions and the way members of the church community live today.

What does it mean for God to love us unconditionally?

Students discuss their ideas about God's relationship with the Jewish people as described in some Old Testament stories.

How can I continue to build a world of love?

Students recognise choices that harm an individual and their loving relationships with God, with others and with all Creation.

How do believers seek to heal relationships?

Students explain ways in which believers seek to heal relationships through reconciliation and how they celebrate reconciliation in the Sacrament of Penance.
